### Register Early!

Classes fill fast. We have limited availability, sign up right away to ensure your spot. Once classes fill, you will have the option to be put on a wait list. The wait list does not guarantee you a spot, it gives you the chance to take the class if someone cancels.

Prompt registration helps avoid disappointment when classes fill quickly. It also helps avoid the disappointment of cancelling a class due to low enrollment, only to find that last minute registrations would have filled it. Early registrations also make it easier if we need to contact you for any reason before your class begins.

### **Registration Policy**

Refunds will not be made after the first class meeting or deadline. A 48-hour notice is required for class cancellation. If supplies or tickets have been purchased, the student will not be issued a refund. If paid online, a processing fee of \$1.50 will be subtracted from the original amount of the class or camp. In the event that class is cancelled, the students will receive a notice by email or telephone. In that case, a full refund will be given via the credit card used for payment or a credit for the entire amount will be applied to your account for later use.




